
ABOUT THE NET

Since 2012, The Net has served over 1,300 survivors of sex trafficking as they have rebuilt their lives and walked forward in freedom.

THE PROBLEM

According to the FBI, less than 1% of trafficking victims are kidnapped. Rather, they are exploited by someone they know and trust.

85-95% of those experiencing exploitation want to escape but have no other options for survival.

buyers who perpetuate the problem are


